- 2. As you read, please annotate your copy by marking important passages. This means you should write notes in the margins about:
 - Characters and their relationships
 - The significance of major actions
 - o The setting
 - o The author's purpose for writing
 - o The point of view the story is told
 - The tone of the author
 - o The theme(s) of the story
 - Circle and then define any unknown words.
 - 3. Bring your book to class the first day.
 - 4. The first week of school we will use the book to complete a project in class.

Assessments include:

*Quiz checking story elements on the first day of school

*One-Pager in which students demonstrate depth of knowledge of the novel through identifying story elements, literary devices such as characterization, style, conflict, resolution, etc., drawing meaningful conclusions concerning author's choices, and citing specific quotes (textual evidence) to prove assertions.
