- I. Read The Red Bandana: A Life. A Choice. A Legacy by Tim Rinaldi. (ISBN-10: 0143130072; ISBN-13:978-0802139252). You may purchase online or from most any bookstore. As you read, annotate the text— marking descriptive character traits, figurative language, interesting details, etc. Annotations will prove beneficial in the first few weeks.
- II. The focus of this biography is Welles Crowther—a coming-of-age young man who searches for his own identity. The author uses many anecdotes, or short stories from Welles' life, in order to illustrate what a hero can look like.
